

# **DEADLINE: March 14, 2025**



In memory of our late friend and colleague, the Montgomery County Consortium of Communities established the Dan Olpere Memorial Annual Conference Scholarship to foster the next generation of local government professionals by funding their attendance to an annual conference.

In Spring 2025, three scholarships will be available to assist early/mid-career professionals and aspiring public administrators currently enrolled in an accredited graduate level public administration program to attend the annual Association for Pennsylvania Municipal Management (APMM). If selected, each recipient will receive up to \$1,000 to cover the cost of registration, meals, and lodging at the Annual APMM Conference in Lancaster, PA on May 19-21.

OR

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS - Applicants must be:

### MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEE APPLICANTS

(1) Be an active member of APMM

AND

(2) Be a full-time employee of a Consortium Municipality STUDENT APPLICANTS

(1) Be currently enrolled in an accredited graduate level public administration program.

The Consortium's Executive Board will review complete applications and announce the Scholarship recipients at their April 10th meeting.
